
Big Block Quiltlet



Overall Size: 18 x 22 All measurements are in inches

Main Block: 10 x 14 Sashing: Horizontal: 2 strips: 10 x4.5 Vertical: 2 strips: 14 x 4.5 Corner Blocks: 4 blocks: 4.5 x 4.5 Backing: 1 Fat Quarter Binding: 84" long of 2 ½" wide coordinating fabric (cut and sewn strips)

Sewing:

- 1. Sew the 2 vertical sashing strips to the inner main block. Press seam towards sashing strips.
- 2. Sew 2 corner blocks to each horizontal sashing strip. Press seam toward sashing strips.
- 3. Set the top sashing strip to the main block piece. Press seams towards sashing.
- 4. Repeat step 3 for the bottom sashing strip. Press.

Assemble:

- 1. Lay down the backing piece, wrong side facing up.
- 2. Layer batting piece on top of backing.
- 3. Lay quiltlet, right side facing up, on top of batting (like making a sandwich)
- 4. Pin along seams you want to stitch (quilt) on the machine.
- 5. Stitch to make your quilt.

Finish:

1. Bind the quiltlet.
