## **Super Easy Pillowcase**

Main Piece - 3/4 yard (cut 27" x 41")

Border Piece - 1/3 yard (cut 10" x 41")

Accent Strip - 1/8 yard (cut 2" x 41")

- 1. Lay 10" border piece **FACE UP** on the table.
- 2. Lay the main piece of pillowcase **FACE UP** on top of the border piece with the two raw edges matching at the top.
- 3. Press the 2" piece in half the long way and lay it **FACE UP** on top of the main piece, matching ALL three raw edges at the top.
- 4. Roll the main fabric from the bottom towards the top. Now fold the border **AROUND** the rolled piece, up to the top and pin all the raw edges together. It looks like you have a fat hot dog!
- 5. Stitch ½" along the edge. You now have a tube of fabric. Turn the tube inside out. And like magic, your pillowcase is nearly finished with no raw edges and a completed finished edge on the front and back!
- 6. Press your hidden seam flat.
- 7. Finish the side seams and border.Fold the pillowcase so that **WRONG** sides are together. Sew a ¼" seam down the side and across the bottom.
- 8. Turn the pillowcase **WRONG** side out and pinch a ½" seam, enclosing the raw edges of the sides and bottom. Stitch. The raw edges of the seams are now enclosed in a "French" seam.
- 9. Press.
- 10. Congratulations! You now have a beautifully finished pillowcase.
